

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

TEA FOR TWO: PINK RIBBON AWARENESS

Targets an under-served neighborhood, knocks on doors and distributes breast health information to women in the community.

PINK SUNDAYS

Invites women and men to worship service on Sundays in October in recognition of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. After the church service, breast cancer information is distributed and refreshments are served.
